Features

From the Manage Users page, Process Discovery Admins can create their own login password for the Event Reporting interface.

Fixes

- You can view the step count for each process from the Mining Runs, Process Explorer, Process View, and Processes pages. For each process, the step count should be the same across all pages. Previously, when you viewed the step count from the Processes page, the step count was incorrect.
- You can select any Mining IDs in the Filters option, even when the mining run you created generates no paths. Previously, when you created a mining run and no paths were found (the Status column is updated to display the path status), you could not search the path using the Mining ID.
- The Observer activity dashboard displays data collected for the observers. Previously, the dashboard displayed zero bytes in the Data Collected graph and zero events in the Events Collected graph.
- You can configure the Observer activity settings even when the Windows username (username listed in the Users column) contains a period. Previously, if the username contained a period, and you configured the Observer settings for that observer, a server error occurred.
